

SCIENCE CAMPS COMBINE FUN WITH LEARNING

This summer, Lawrence Parks and Recreation Department offered eight unique camps from Mad Science of Kansas City for youth ages 7-13 years-old.

Participants experienced the world of science through rockets, robots and space. Campers learned to build their own robots, build and shoot off rockets in South Park and studied Newton's

Laws of motion.

LPRD also offered a camp for those younger than 7 years-old. *My First Science Lab* was attended by camper's ages 4 years-old to 6 years-old, where participants were introduced to the basics of environmental science. The kids performed hands on experiments, played themed games that went along with a story and also received their own lab coat and goggles.
