



CENTENNIAL PARK SKATEPARK UPGRADE
Lawrence Parks and Recreation Department's district two staff is currently conducting repairs at Centennial Skate Park.

The half-pipe at the park needed to be redone and the skating surface was no longer completely intact, becoming a potential hazard to users of the park.

In addition, some of the framework was rotting and needed replaced. District two staff removed the old skating surface and then disassembled the framework and siding so they could replace the bad lumber and staff is currently installing the new skate surface. The original structure lasted more than fifteen years, and the staff is confident with this rebuild, there will be many years of use and enjoyment ahead for area skaters.
