ITEM NO. 4:

Consider request to construct a TRAFFIC SIGNAL at the intersection of Bob Billings Parkway & Stone Meadows Drive.

# Staff Report:

- 1. The *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices* (MUTCD) provides Warrants for consideration of a traffic signal.
- 2. Traffic data was collected for 24 hours at this intersection on September 23-24.
- 3. A review of Police Department records found only one (1) reported crash during the past three (3) years susceptible to correction by a traffic signal.
- 4. None of the Warrants in the MUTCD for consideration of a traffic signal are currently met at this intersection.

## ITEM NO. 4:

Woosley reviewed the information provided in the staff report.

### **Public Comment:**

Betty Alderson, 1400 Lilac Lane: I do not live in this area, but I would like to speak to it, I have several friends that do; there is no sight line either to the east or west if you're coming-off Stone Meadows Drive onto Bob Billings Parkway; it's right at the top of a very steep hill and you don't see a car until they're on top of you; many people avoid that intersection because of the safety concerns; I don't know that this is the answer, but I hope there is something you can come up with to help the situation.

Pat Kelly, 1301 Stone Meadows Drive: I'm here to plead for the neighborhood; our only convenient way to get to the east is on 15<sup>th</sup> Street and you cannot see to the left or the right with cars coming at 40mph until they are almost on you; it really is incredibly dangerous; our only alternative is to use Harvard, but that is out of the way; I hope you will seriously consider it.

### Commission Discussion:

Commissioner Rothrock: I think if we did similar studies at Wagon Wheel or Inverness, they would have significantly higher levels of traffic; my feeling is that this is not the right place to put a stop light.

Commissioner Harden: If it fails to meet the warrants, I would recommend denial.

Dear Commission Members,

We are writing to request a traffic study be done on the intersection of Stone Meadows Drive and Bob Billings Parkway for the possible installation of a traffic signal.

After talking with fellow neighbors who live north on and near Stone Meadows Drive regarding the increasing difficulty of turning, either east or west, onto Bob Bill Parkway at the present time, many of us are concerned about the additional traffic that will be using this street now that the Westside interchange has been approved.

There are additional reasons for the need for a traffic signal at this intersection, including but not limited to the high density-units immediately north of Stone Meadows Drive and Bob Billings Parkway; the "blindness" of the intersection because of the hills in that area; and, as pointed out by City Commissioner Terry Riordan, the speed at which cars are presently traveling Bob Billings Parkway. These challenges will only be exacerbated by the development of the coming Westside interchange.

Thank you for the work you do to make the city of Lawrence a safe community.
