Date: January 31, 2014 RE: 2014 Wage Floor

Pursuant to the City's Tax Abatement Policy (Code Section 1-2101 *et seq.*), the wage floor hourly wage is adjusted annually based upon an annual wage "equal to one hundred thirty percent (130%) of the federal poverty threshold for a family of three (3), as established by the United States Department of Health and Human Services." The 2014 HHS Poverty Guidelines, published January 22, 2014 in the Federal Register (Vol. 79, No. 14, pp 3593-2594), establish the poverty level for a family of three at \$19,790. Therefore, the wage floor hourly wage will increase from \$12.21 in 2013 to \$12.37 in 2014. (\$19,790 x 1.3 = \$25,727/2080 hours in one year = \$12.37/hour).

Below is a summary of the wage floor amounts since the inception of Ordinance 7706, and later Ordinance 8384:
