
Pilot program for yard waste collection during winter months

The city's yard waste collection program runs March through mid-December (the growing season). In January and February there is usually little to no yard waste. Due to the warmer weekends this winter, trash collection crews have seen an increase in yard waste set out at the curb.

As a result of the increase in yard waste set out, and in effort to keep this material out of the landfill, the city began a pilot program on Monday, January 27th to collect yard waste separate from trash for the remaining winter months. Residents may request a special yard waste pick-up by completing an online form available at www.lawrenceks.org/swm or by calling the Solid Waste Division at 832-3032. The special pick-up service will be available until March when the city-wide residential Monday yard waste collection begins.



During the first three days of the pilot program, approximately 300 residents requested a special yard waste pickup. Residents were asked how they heard about the pilot program. See results below:
