#### EARTH DAY PARADE MANAGEMENT PLAN

#### **GENERAL OVERVIEW:**

On Saturday April 19<sup>th</sup> at 1100 hours, the Earth Day Parade will begin. Staging will be on 7<sup>th</sup> Street, beside Buford Watson Park, with parade movement east to Massachusetts, and then south to South Park Street. The Earth Day Celebration will then commence in South Park immediately following the parade.

The communications will be on GCOM 1.

#### **STAGING and MOVEMENT:**

At 1000 hours, staging will begin in the 300 block of W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street beside Buford Watson Park. At 1100 hours the parade will begin moving. The parade route is east on West 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Massachusetts, then south on Massachusetts to South Park Street. Participants then exit into the LEC lot, or walk directly into South Park for the Earth Day Celebration.

Entries are an undetermined number of floats, vehicles, bicycles or unknown type of entry. 5-10 vehicles are expected, with an undetermined number of people (approx. 200), bicycles or vehicles. People observing the parades are also welcome to walk into the parade to be a participant.

#### **SIGNS AND BARRICADES:**

- Emergency no parking signs will be erected on both sides of 7<sup>th</sup> Street from Tennessee to Kentucky on Friday April 18th, 2014 by 0900 hours.
- Barricades will be erected at 7<sup>th</sup> and Tennessee to block east bound traffic.
- Barricades will be erected at 7<sup>th</sup> and Kentucky to block westbound traffic.
- Barricades erected at 8<sup>th</sup> and Vermont
- Barricades erected at 9<sup>th</sup> and Vermont
- Barricades erected at 10<sup>th</sup> and Vermont
- Barricades erected at 11<sup>th</sup> and Vermont
- Barricades erected at 7<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire
- Barricades erected at 8<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire
- Barricades erected at 9<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire
- Barricades erected at 10<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire
- Barricades erected at 11<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire

### POLICE RESOURCES:

- 1. **Incident Commander**: <u>Sgt. Fultz- Unit 194</u>, will be assigned as the Incident Commander and remain available by telephone, (785) 423-4672 after 1000 hours for parade staff. This supervisor will address concerns between parade officials and patrol and may be also be contacted via the dispatch center at 832-7509.
- Lead Patrol Car: <u>Ofc. Walter 1X1</u>, will lead the parade in a marked patrol car. The officer will report to 7<sup>th</sup> and Kentucky at 1000 hours and will erect barricades and assist with traffic control as necessary until the parade begins.
- 3. **Tail Patrol Car:** <u>Ofc. Anglin- Unit 1X2</u> will follow the parade in a marked patrol car. The officer will report to 7<sup>th</sup> and Kentucky at 1000 hours and will erect barricades and assist with traffic control as necessary until the parade begins.
- 4. **7<sup>th</sup> and Vermont**: at 1100 hours <u>Ofc. Rhoden- Unit 1X3</u> Will conduct traffic control at beginning of parade.
- 5. **7<sup>th</sup> and Tennessee**: at 1000 hours, <u>Ofc. Bradford Unit 1X4</u> will be stationed to assist with parade participant drop off.
- 6. 7<sup>th</sup> and Kentucky: At 1100 hours <u>Ofc. Burke- Unit 1X5</u> will stop traffic Northbound on Kentucky at 7<sup>th</sup> Street, until all parade participants cross Kentucky. That officer will then take down all barricades in the staging area to allow all traffic through. This officer will coordinate with the 7<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts officer to take down barricades on the peripheral streets as the parade progresses south.
- 7. Foot Patrol: At 1045 hours, two officers, <u>Officer Leslie Unit 1X6, and Officer Smith Unit 1X7</u>, will erect barricades at 7<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire, 8<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire, 9<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire, 10<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire, and 11<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire. The other officer will erect barricades at 8<sup>th</sup> and Vermont, 9<sup>th</sup> and Vermont, 10<sup>th</sup> and Vermont and 11<sup>th</sup> and Vermont. Officer will then patrol the sidewalks adjacent to the parade.
- 8. **12<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts**: At 1100 hours, <u>Ofc. Bishop- Unit 1X8</u> will erect barricades at 12<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts Street to stop all northbound traffic. That officer will remain at 12<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts to control traffic.
- 7<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts: At 1100 hours, <u>Ofc. Gillum- Unit 1X9</u> will be assigned to 7<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts to stop southbound traffic. Once the parade is passed 8<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts, that officer will move up to 8<sup>th</sup> and Massachusetts.
- 10. Bike Patrol Officers **Byrn, and Bialek** will help foot patrol erect barricades, then stay close to the parade and control any traffic issues that need addressed.
