My choice would be: Lawrence City Sports Complex

Ad Astra Center would be my choice of the five listed.

Kanza Center

The only name that sounds sports or recreation related is SportQuest. If you are having a conversation with someone it also rolls off the tongue smoother than OneLawrence Center or Ad Astra Center. Kanza Center or Freedom Center could be the names of anything from a homeless shelter to an after school youth center. Ad Astra Center is the best of those 5 by far.

Choose a straightforward name which includes the name of our city and recreation, with 'Corporate Name' before and 'at Rock Chalk Park' after. - Lawrence Recreation - RecreateLawrence (The following dovetail with other City recreation names.) - West Lawrence Recreation Center -Lawrence Recreation Ce

First of all, SportQuest is an awful name. It sounds like the name of a defunct '90s soccer team or something. Freedom Center is too universal, and doesn't really reflect the "Kansas-ness" that this park should project. OneLawrence Center sounds too much like a business park. Ad Astra Center and Kanza Center are the best two of the names provided, both exuding distinct vibes and properly reflecting the heritage of Kansas. Additionally, I think "Free State Center" should be considered.
