On Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, the City of Lawrence City Utilities Ecoflow program will be conducting an open house at the Douglas County Fairgrounds, Dreher Building from 6-9pm. This meeting is free to attend and will provide information about the City of Lawrence's Ecoflow program.

Ecoflow is a rapid rainwater reduction program with the goals of renewing and repairing the City's aging sanitary sewer system. The open house will allow the City of Lawrence and partner, TREKK Design Group, to go into detail about the common problems and the proper private connection repairs needed to improve the Lawrence sanitary system.

At the open house, you will also be able to schedule a free plumbing evaluation on your property to identify any improper connections to the sewer system. Improper connections include uncapped cleanouts and downspouts, sump pumps and area drains that allow rainwater/groundwater to enter. If improper connections are found, property owners will be asked to allow a qualified plumber, PAID BY THE CITY, to correct the issue.
