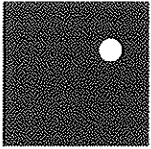
Saturday, July 26 from 7 am to 10 pm for the official dedication ceremony and the Dinner and a Movie event with Downtown Lawrence, Inc.

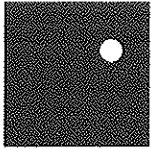
