ITEM NO. 2: Consider request for TRAFFIC CALMING on Trail Road between Eldridge Street and Folks Road.

Staff Report:

- 1. Trail Road is classified as a "collector" street in a residential area and is paved approximately 26 feet wide with a sidewalk along the north side of the street.
- 2. Parking is permitted along both sides of Trail Road.
- 3. The posted speed limit on Trail Road is 30mph.
- 4. The City's Policy permits TRAFFIC CALMING on a "collector" street if the 85th percentile speed of traffic is 5mph or greater over the speed limit or if the 24-hour 2-way traffic volume is greater than 3000.

 Traffic data collected March 31-April 1, 2014, found approximately 1675 vehicles in a 24-hour period and an 85th percentile speed of approximately 38.25mph; therefore, this portion of Trail Road meets the minimum criteria for consideration of TRAFFIC CALMING.

Consider request to construct a ROUNDABOUT at the intersection of Folks Road and Overland Drive.

Staff Report:

- 1. Traffic data was obtained at this intersection March 31 April 1.

Public Comment:

Amy Berth, 400 Terri Court: The police department has been in our neighborhood several times trying to help curb the traffic problems we have; since Free State High School opened, we've seen a tremendous amount of traffic on Trail; the problems we have noticed is mainly the speed, is outrageous; most of the traffic that goes down Trail, I believe, are young adults, they haven't been a parent, they're not a grandparent, they're just trying to get to school as fast as they can without being late; I don't know what else can be done, aside from speed bumps like Harvard and on Folks across 6th Street, perhaps that would slow them down; when the police department is there, they slow down a little bit, but, 24 hours later they forget; the speeding down Trail, we see more when school is on and more with events; I appreciate anything you can do to help us out.

Mark Engleman, 4200 Trail Road: We have definitely a speed issue; needs to be probably speed bumps that would slow it down dramatically; the speeding during the summer is still sporadic, but they still blast down the street.

Glynn Sheridan, 4116 Trail Road: I can repeat everything that has been shared with you; I think we've all seen it; the speed's become out of hand; the terrain even contributes to the speed; I'm certainly of the mindset that some sort of traffic calming like on Harvard would be appreciated.

Laura Bogart, 4120 Trail Road: We spend a lot of time outside and it gets very dangerous trying to cross the street; the whole strip of Trail from Monterey Way, all the way down, people do go real fast; we would really appreciate some slowing down; we think some type of speed bumps along Trail Road would help with that.
