Dear Mr. Soules:

On June 10, 2014, bids were opened and read aloud in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders for the above referenced improvements to the Lawrence Municipal Airport. Three bids were received (bid tabulation enclosed). The low bidder, Capital Electric Construction Company, Inc. submitted a proposal for \$219,745.00, which was 6.2% above the engineer's estimate of \$206,895.00.

The bid submitted by Capital Electric meets the following proposal requirements:

- Submitted the lowest bid for Schedule I.
- Submitted a Bid Bond for at least 5 percent of the total bid.
- Submitted an acceptable Statement of Qualifications.

The available entitlement funds from the FAA should be sufficient to complete the contract. Enclosed find a summary of the project costs including this bid. Since the bidder met the proposal requirements and seems qualified to construct this project, we recommend award of AIP Project No. 3-20-0047-20, Schedule I to Capital Electric Construction Company, Inc. The funds for the project will be paid for from the AIP 3-20-0047-20 grant, which should be offered by the FAA after they receive the requested documentation. Award of the project shall not be until FAA concurrence is made, and the award of the construction contract should be made contingent upon receipt of FAA grant offer.
