

## JUSTIFICATION:


The airport is partially fenced with a three-strand barbed wire fence and does not have gates at most entrances. A key recommendation from the 2012 Wildlife Hazard Assessment of the airport was the installation of a woven wire wildlife fence on the airport perimeter following the property line. This project will significantly deter wildlife incursions on the field and lower the city's liability risk of wildlife and aircraft collisions. The new fence will include chain-link fencing in the main building area and will include manual and automatic gates for access control.

## JUSTIFICATION:

To maintain a smooth flow of ground traffic, increase the airport's margin of safety for ground operations, and to increase runway capacity, a partial parallel taxiway to Runway 1-19 will be constructed, This taxiway will be located on the east side of the runway at a separation of 225 feet from the runway centerline and a width of 25 feet. Medium intensity taxiway edge lighting and airfield signage will be included in this item. Pavements will be designed to accommodate 12,500 lbs. SWG and marked in accordance with current standards.


Construction offset parallel taxiway to Runway 1-19 will eliminate the need to back taxi on the north end of the runway.

## JUSTIFICATION:


The main apron at LWC has an old coal tar slurry that is cracked (egg-shelled) and needs to be resurfaced. There are areas on the apron that need to be reconstructed due to heavy business jet traffic along with typical weathering and cracking over time. The rehabilitation will include milling off the existing surface and applying an overlay. Reconstruction will include full-depth asphalt removal, preparation of the underlying base and reconstruction of the asphalt section.

## JUSTIFICATION:

The main Runway (15-33) currently has weathering and block cracking throughout. A 2013 sealcoat project extended the life of the surface but resurfacing will be necessary by 2018. The rehabilitation will include milling off the existing surface and applying an overlay. No reconstruction areas are anticipated. Also, new surface markings and striping will be required per FAA design standards on the reconstructed surface.


The overlay will add strength and enhanced service longevity to the runway and provide increased utility to heavier business jets using the airport.

## JUSTIFICATION:



The tracts will be acquired in fee. Note: The thin purple property tract on the west side of the airfield has already been acquired under a previous FAA grant.

#### JUSTIFICATION:


Recommendations from the 2012 Wildlife Hazard Assessment and 2014 Environmental Assessment are driving improvements to drainage enhancements at the south end of the airport property. These enhancements will reduce wildlife habitat for avian species and create a safer operating environment for aircraft; and better manage waterflow throughout the Kaw Valley Drainage District. Also, these improvements will recover additional acreage of airport property that potentially could be used for revenue-producing property at the airport. A complete list of the recommendations will be finalized in 2015 when the Environmental Assessment is complete and presented to the city.

# JUSTIFICATION:

To meet market demand and access to the Lawrence Municipal Airport by larger, heavier business jets, Runway 15-33 will be extended from 5,700 feet to 6,100 feet to accommodate ARC class C and D aircraft with significant nautical mile range.
