Lawrence Community Shelter currently employs the following persons:

Trey Meyer. Operations and Program Development. Mr. Meyer is responsible for all aspects of day-to-day operations and is currently overseeing all staff.

Sally Bartlett and Sonya Robinson. Adult Case Managers. Ms. Bartlett and Ms. Robinson work with our guests on a daily basis to determine what services they need and to refer them to the appropriate resources to obtain those services. This includes, among other areas, housing, employment, substance use disorders, mental and physical health, and financial skills. Both of our case managers typically manage and assist about 50 guests at a time. Ms. Bartlett and Ms. Robinson also perform the vital and difficult function of managing all admissions into and discharges from LCS.

Rebecca Esparza. Ms. Esparza supervises our family program. As with our adult case managers, Ms. Esparza, works with parents and children every day to determine what services they need and to refer them to the appropriate resources to obtain those services. In addition to the services mentioned above, Ms. Esparza also works closely with a number of collaborating partners to connect guests with parent coaching and training, individual and family counseling and therapy, and many educational resources.

Drew VonEhrenkrook. Mr. VonEhrenkrook supervises our employment and vocational rehabilitation programs. He works closely with guests to identify employment opportunities, prepare resumés, prepare for interviews, further their education via GED completion and similar programs. Mr. VonEhrenkrook also currently helps a great deal with day-to-day operations.
