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The Outreach Team has helped house 9 individuals obtain housing this quarter.

The team has been referring clients to Salvation Army as they recently received a grant that will house chronically homeless individuals with Bert Nash providing the case management and other services needed to maintain their housing. This will house four individuals, however more is needed. The number of chronically homeless individuals has been increasing. Last year at this time we were working with 68 individuals designated as chronically homeless. This year that number has increased to 81.
