

HOW TO PROTEST A REZONING IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE

If you own property which lies within 200 feet of a proposed rezoning and you oppose the rezoning, you may file a protest petition in opposition to it.

If the petition is found to be valid, approval of the rezoning the approval of a $\frac{3}{4}$ majority of the members of the City Commission present and voting on the matter (rather than a simple majority).

- A. For a protest petition against a rezoning to be valid it must meet the following requirements:
1. It must be duly signed and acknowledged by the owner or owners of 20% or more of the real property, excluding streets and public ways, within 200 feet of the land for which the rezoning has been proposed.
 2. It must be filed with the City Clerk before 5:00 p.m. on or before the 14th day after the date of the conclusion of the Planning Commission public hearing. The day following the Planning Commission shall be counted as the first day. If the 14th day falls on a weekend or holiday, the Petition must be filed before 5:00 p.m. on the first business day following that weekend or holiday.
- B. Facts about the petition:
1. The "owner" for the purpose of a protest petition is defined as the owner of record (recorded for purposes of taxation) on the date of publication of the legal notice for the Planning Commission public hearing.
 2. Each and every owner of a single piece of property must sign the protest petition, but all are considered as a single owner in determining the sufficiency of the petition.
 3. An authorized representative of a corporation may sign, but must provide a legal documentation of his or her right to sign for the corporation.
 4. The protest petition should state what is being protested, its general location, and the reasons for the protest.
