The Lawrence Waste Reduction & Recycling Division assists Kansas Small Quantity Generator (SQG) businesses with proper and affordable disposal of hazardous waste. Call **832-3030** for your waste inventory and disposal cost estimate.

A Kansas Small Quantity Generator is a business that generates less than 55 pounds of hazardous waste, or less than 2.2 pounds of acutely hazardous waste in a calendar month. Don't know your hazardous waste generator status? Call the Kansas Department of Health & Environment at 842-4600.

Hazardous materials accepted include: latex and oil-based paints, pesticides, thinners and other solvents, adhesives, industrial use cleaners, mercury, automotive products, batteries, aerosols, fluorescent bulbs.

Hazardous materials NOT accepted: asbestos, ammunition, explosives, infectious waste (medical waste), radioactive waste.
