

2008 Comparative Property Tax Burdens For Health Department and Dispatch

Explanatory Note:

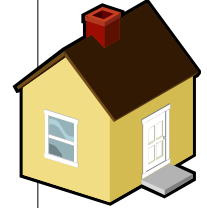
These tax burden calculations are based on 2008 City and County budgeted funds for Health Department and Dispatch operations.

The City pays 40% (\$652,300) and the County pays 60% (\$977,999) of Health Department operations. These figures include only operating costs, and do not include debt service or maintenance on the Community Health Building, which houses other agencies in addition to the Health Department. Residents of the City of Lawrence pay both City and County taxes to support Health Department operations.

The City pays 66% (\$985,000) and the County pays 34% (\$507,424) of Dispatch operations. Residents of the City of Lawrence pay both City and County taxes to support Dispatch operations.
