65 gallon capacity for \$1.50 per month.

Collection Information

Residential Refuse Collection

The City of Lawrence begins residential refuse collection service at 7 a.m. (Monday yard trimmings collection at 6 a.m.). Please have all refuse out by this time on your day of service.

Containers

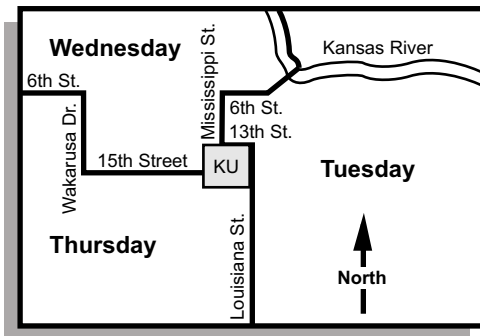
 (see right panel for yard trimmings containers)

Watertight containers of metal or plastic with a tight-fitting cover and two outside handles of no more than 35 gallon capacity are accepted. Plastic bags of no more than 35 gallon capacity, secured tightly with enough grasping room left at the top are also accepted.

Single containers should weigh **no more than 65 pounds each** as they are manually collected. (Rented wheeled carts allowed to weigh more. Available by calling 832-3032.)

For more information call 832-3032 or consult City Code chapter 9 for correct containment of refuse.

Residential Weekly Collection Schedule



Monday See "Yard Trimmings Collection" at right.

Tuesday

- North Lawrence (north & east of Kansas River).
- East of Louisiana St. & south of 6th St.
- East of Mississippi St. between 6th & 13th St. only.

Wednesday

- North of 15th St., west of Mississippi St. & east of Wakarusa.
- North of 6th St. from Tennessee St. west to the City Limits.

Thursday

- South of 15th St. from Louisiana St. west to the City Limits.
- South of 6th St. & west of Wakarusa to the City Limits.

Services

Automobile Tires

Five passenger tires per household per year picked up free. Additional/oversized tires accepted for a small charge. Curbside collection by appointment only. Call the Solid Waste Division at 832-3032 to schedule a pickup. Many tire retailers will also accept waste tires for a small fee.

Bulky Items Pickup

Refrigerators, washers, dryers, hide-a-beds, etc. Curbside collection by appointment only. Call the Solid Waste Division at 832-3032 to schedule a pickup.

Christmas Trees

Seasonal only. Dates to be announced. Call 832-3032 for more information.

Yard Trimmings Collection

Monday curbside collection, March-December. Please contain yard waste in cans, City carts or compostable paper bags. See right-hand panel or call 832-3032 for more information.

Household Hazardous Waste

Drop off unwanted automotive products, household cleaning products, paints & hobby supplies, pest control products, etc. Call the Waste Reduction & Recycling Division at 832-3030 to schedule a drop-off appointment.

Household Sharps Disposal

Household sharps such as needles should be packaged in a puncture proof container (detergent bottle, coffee can, etc.) with a secure taped lid for trash pick-up. Please label the container "Sharps".

Used Motor Oil Drop-Off

Woody Debris Drop-Off

1420 East 11th, (two blocks east of 11th and Haskell) Every Saturday 10 a.m.- 4 p.m., mid-April through mid-November • \$ 5.00 per load. Woody (tree) debris only, No RR ties, lumber, etc. For more details call Forestry at 832-7979.

Yard Trimmings Collection

Lawrence Composts

Mulch mowing, backyard composting, and Monday yard trimmings collection are all ways to return your excess plant materials to the earth. Collection is seasonal (March-December) and is for small trimmings, grass, and leaves. These materials are composted. If using lawn herbicides, please ensure it does not contain Clopyralid, which persists in compost and can later damage sensitive plants. If using such a product, please mulch mow your clippings.

Materials should be set out by 6:00 a.m. in a **can, City cart, or compostable paper yard waste bag** for Monday yard trimmings collection.

To **recycle woody debris**, drop it off on specified Saturdays (see Services/Woody Debris), or place smaller woody debris out on Monday for composting. Items may be **placed in cans, City carts, or compostable paper yard waste bags** (if sticking out less than 12 inches and less than 65 lbs.).

Woody waste bundles set out on trash day will be taken to the landfill if they:

- Do not exceed 5 feet in length nor exceed 18 inches in diameter.
- Do not weigh more than 65 lbs. per bundle.
