LAWRENCE CITY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE DIVERSION PROGRAM

The following guidelines have been adopted by the Lawrence City Prosecutor's Office for the diversion program in Lawrence Municipal Court. These guidelines supersede prior policies or guidelines and become effective September 1, 2023.

Diversion is a privilege and not a right. No presumption in favor of diversion exists in any case, and the burden of persuasion rests with the applicant to establish that a diversion agreement will best serve the ends of justice and the interests of the community, public safety, and the rights of the victims.

Eligibility; Factors Considered

In determining whether or not diversion is appropriate, the City Prosecutor's Office will consider a number of factors, including, but not limited to the following:

- 1. The nature of the crime and the circumstances surrounding it.
- 2. Any special characteristics and circumstances of the defendant.
- 3. Whether the defendant is a first-time offender.
- 4. Whether the diversion program is appropriate to the needs of the defendant.
- 5. The impact of diversion on the community.
- 6. Recommendations of the involved law enforcement community.
- 7. Recommendations of the victim.
- 8. The amount of restitution, if applicable, owed by the defendant.
- 9. Any mitigating or aggravating circumstances surrounding the crime.
- 10. Whether there is a probability, the defendant committed the crime as a result of an injury, including major depressive disorder, polytrauma, post-traumatic stress disorder or traumatic brain injury connected to service in a combat zone while in the U.S. Armed Forces; and, if so, whether there is a probability the defendant will cooperate with and benefit from inpatient or outpatient treatment in a facility operated by the U.S. Dept. of Defense, the U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs or the Kansas National Guard, with the defendant's consent.

Exclusions

- 1. A defendant who has a **commercial driver's license** (CDL) is **NOT** eligible for diversion of any traffic offense.
- 2. A defendant charged with operating under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be eligible for diversion if:
 - (a) the defendant has a previous conviction or diversion for operating under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or
 - (b) the defendant was, at the time of the alleged operating under the influence, involved in a motor vehicle accident resulting in injury or death of another person, or
 - (c) the defendant has, or at the time of the offense, had a commercial driver's license.
- 3. A defendant who has an <u>outstanding balance owed to Lawrence Municipal Court</u> is not eligible for diversion until the balance owed to Lawrence Municipal Court is zero.

Procedures

You may turn this application in to the Lawrence Municipal Court Clerk accompanied with the required documentation applicable to the offense(s) charged. See pages 2-4 for the list of requirements and approved providers. The application review process may take up to 4-6 weeks. A formal diversion conference may be required. The City Prosecutor's Office will notify you or your attorney in writing whether your diversion agreement has been approved or denied. If the City Prosecutor approves you for diversion, the terms and conditions will be reduced to writing for approval and signature by both parties.

ALL COURT APPEARANCES MUST BE ATTENDED DURING THE APPLICATION

PROCESS. FAILURE TO APPEAR IN COURT BEFORE SUBMISSION OF AN ORIGINAL SIGNED AND INITIALED DIVERSION AGREEMENT WILL RESULT IN A BENCH WARRANT.

Required Documentation

- **A.** The diversion application **must** be completed on the form provided. You may attach additional pages.
- B. A diversion application will not be accepted for a charge of <u>Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Drugs (OUI)</u> without an accompanying <u>alcohol/substance abuse evaluation</u>.
- C. A diversion application will not be accepted for a charge of <u>Possession/Purchase/Consumption</u> of an Alcoholic Beverage by <u>Underage Persons</u> (<u>MIP</u>) without <u>proof of completion of an approved alcohol and drug information school.</u>
- D. A diversion application will not be accepted for a charge of **Possession of Marijuana** without **proof of completion of an approved alcohol and drug information school.**
- E. A diversion application will not be accepted for a charge of **No Insurance** without **proof of current liability insurance** that lists the defendant as a covered driver. *If you do not own a vehicle*, you may submit **proof of current NON-OWNER'S liability insurance**.
- F. A diversion application will not be accepted for a charge of <u>Theft</u> without <u>proof of completion</u> <u>of an approved theft prevention program.</u>
- G. A diversion application will not be accepted for a charge of **No Ignition Interlock** without **proof of current ignition interlock.**

The Diversion Agreement

The standard diversion agreement length is twelve months and <u>may</u> include the following terms:

- 1. Do not violate the law.
- 2. Complete the treatment recommendations of a substance abuse/drug/alcohol evaluation.
- 3. Attend alcohol/drug information school.
- 4. Attend a presentation of the DUI Victim Panel.
- 5. Complete a theft prevention program.
- 6. Complete anger management.
- 7. Complete hours of community service work.
- 8. Pay restitution.
- 9. Pay diversion fees, along with court costs and other administrative fees.
- 10. Complete the treatment recommendations of a domestic violence assessment.
- 11. Complete the treatment recommendations of a mental health evaluation.
- 11. Any other term deemed appropriate for your circumstances.

The executed diversion agreement will be filed with the Lawrence Municipal Court and criminal proceedings will be suspended as long as the defendant fulfills all the terms and conditions of the diversion agreement. If at any time during the diversionary period the City Prosecutor finds that the defendant is not fulfilling the terms and conditions of the diversion agreement, the City Prosecutor may file a Motion to Revoke the diversion agreement and resume criminal proceedings.

Upon successful completion of the terms and conditions of the diversion agreement, the charge(s) will be dismissed with prejudice.
