

PLEASE, PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET!

Properly dispose of pet waste by placing it in a bag and throwing it in the trash.

Pet waste left in yards, parks, and other outdoor areas washes away into storm sewers or ditches that flow directly into our streams, lakes, and rivers. Pet waste contains pathogens and excess nutrients that have been identified as primary pollutants in the Kansas River + other local streams and ponds. These pollutants destroy our natural resources and threaten public health.

City Code 9-1102 (C) (7) requires that pet waste be disposed of properly to prevent discharge into the storm drainage system.

HELP KEEP OUR WATERWAYS CLEAN:

- Carry a bag with you on every walk and you'll have everything you need to remove pet waste
- Avoid letting your dog do their business within 200 feet of a water body
- Remember to regularly pick up after all pets at home and do not attempt to compost their waste
